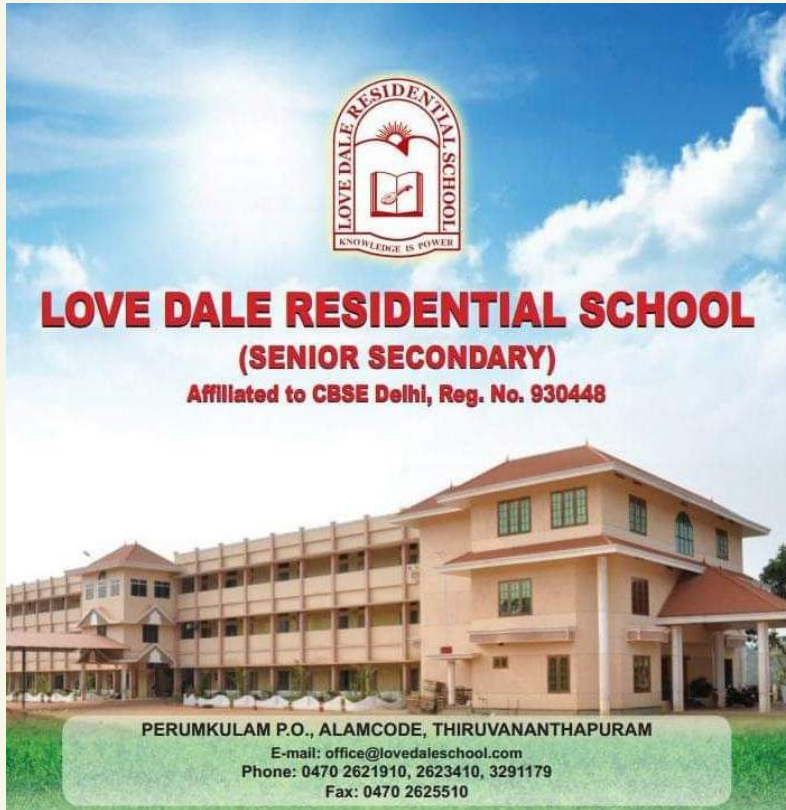

The school was established in 1998 and began its first academic year on June 1st of that year. At that time, there was only one building with 5 classrooms and a single staff room. The school enrolled 74 students in its first year. The school underwent the affiliation process and received affiliation on April 1st, 2003. This year marks the silver jubilee of the institution.

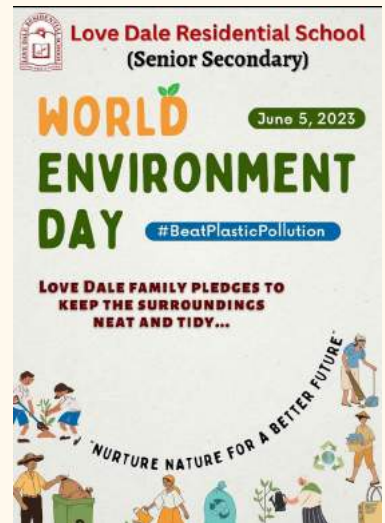

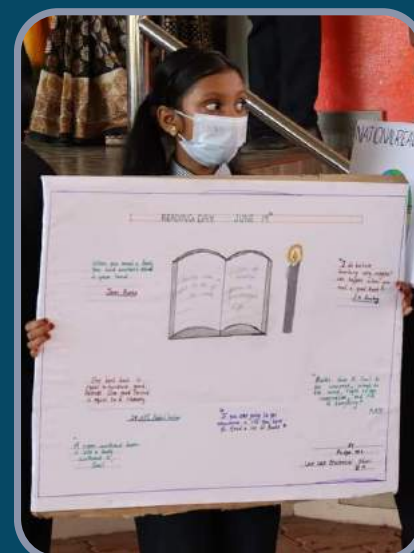

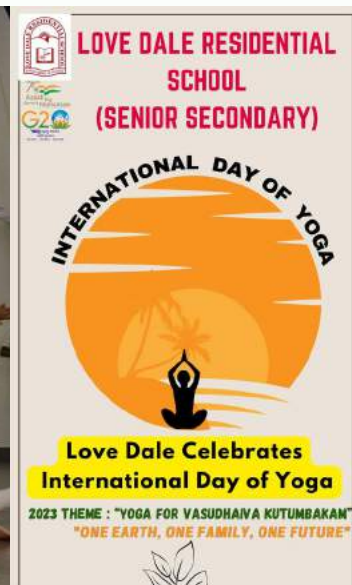
